

Shropshire Junior Netball League Match Guidance

Match Venue:

The Telford Langley School: Duce Drive, Dawley, Telford, TF4 3JS

Arrival Times:

Please arrive 30 mins before the start of your first match and meet near the courts (through reception and the canteen).

Safeguarding and Emergency Contacts:

Coaches and committee are not responsible for players beyond the court. A parent/carer should stay on site to oversee their child at all other times. This should be somebody who, should an accident occur, would be willing to engage with first aiders and emergency services over any health issues.

If players are sharing lifts, please be mindful of this responsibility passing on to the agreed adult who remains on site.

Unable to Play?

Please notify your squad coach as early as you can; using the club's WhatsApp is the quickest method.

League Matches Cancelled

If matches are cancelled due to bad weather/or other incident, this is usually done at 08.30 on the morning (earlier if bad snow). A WhatsApp message will be posted as soon as the club is notified

Kit for Matches:

Playing kit (skirt and tops or dresses) will be provided by the club and remain property of the club. These must be worn at matches as part of league rules.

Matches will be played outside and the venue is notoriously cold! Wearing a black long sleeved tee shirt/leggings (skins) under match kit is recommended.

Players should wear warm clothes such as a tracksuit, warm jacket, gloves and a hat to warm-up and to wear when not on court. If rain is due water-proofs are recommended as matches will still be played.



All jewellery must be removed, including earrings, necklaces, watches and other wrist devices; hair should be tied back; nails should be kept short.

Drinks and Snacks:

Please bring plenty to drink (water or squash) and energy snacks for between matches and after matches. A hot drink may be wise if you have 2 matches on the same day and there is a gap between them

Kit Bag:

A kit bag is really useful to keep kit dry while players are on court and it helps to ensure named water bottles and snacks are not lost.

Players and Spectators:

Both players, parents and any spectators should agree to and follow the league code of conduct at all times. Copies of these can be found on our website.
