Team Training & Match Dress Code



We hate having to mention this but, we have had a few issues with inappropriate attire at training recently, and so here is a reminder of the England Netball rules regarding what to wear to keep yourself and others safe:

- Your <u>T Shirt or top</u> should be suitable for training; i.e. without any big buttons, metal fastenings, not strappy across the shoulders or with embellishments as these can lead to injury should a player catch themselves on them.
- <u>Trainers</u> that provide proper foot support, cushioning and <u>tread</u> are vital. They should be suitable to run around in......
 If you are looking to buy some more trainers, do consider looking at the following website https://www.netballuk.co.uk. They are very knowledgeable and happy to give out advice.
- <u>All jewellery</u> must be removed, including earrings, nose studs, necklaces, bracelets, watches and other wrist devices; <u>You cannot 'tape' a piercing over to make it safe, it MUST be removed.</u>
- Hair should be fully tied back i.e. not half up/half down and should be held with a soft tie / scrunchie, nothing with beads.
- Nails should be kept short. As a guideline, nails should be no longer than 1mm long and should not be visible over your fingertips. If they are too long, players will not be permitted to play until they are cut or filed down. This is to protect other players from injury.
- Please bring a <u>water bottle</u> with you to training so that you do not need to leave the hall and use the Leisure Centre fountain!

As an affiliated club, we cannot allow you to play if you are not following these rules and will have to ask you to sit out the session.

This rule will be enforced from the 23rd February session.
